In the Circuit Court of Jackson County, Independence, Missouri.

The State of Missouri to any peace officer in the State of Missouri:

Whereas, on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2009, an Application for Issuance of a Search Warrant and Affidavit(s) in writing, duly verified by oath or affirmation, has been filed with the undersigned Judge of this Court, stating that heretofore the following described property is subject to seizure, to-wit:

Any and all photographs, videos, writings, magazines, books, journals, or other evidence depicting and/or describing minor children, nude or partially nude, in a sexually explicit manner, or depicting minor children engaged in sexual activity with persons of any age, or with any animals. This will include any computer CPUS, jump drives, floppy discs, CDS, DVDS, hard drives, software, audio recordings, or other video or audio recording devices where such minor children material could be stored. This will also include any items commonly referred to as "trophies" of such illegal activity in the past, with persons of any age.

and it further appears that there is PROBABLE CAUSE to believe that said property subject to seizure is being kept or held in this county and state on the following person, place or thing, to-wit:

The basement of the residence at [redacted] Independence, Jackson County Missouri, an off-white cream colored one story residence at the southwest corner of [redacted] and [redacted] with the front door facing [redacted] (east). The house numbers [redacted] are on the house near the east facing walkin door. On the north side of the residence is a walkin door facing [redacted] Street, that allows access to the full basement of the residence. On the west side of the residence is an alley and driveway access to an open garage and a walkin door accessing a porch and the kitchen.

The kitchen is located at the northwest corner of the residence and a wooden door on the south wall of the kitchen allows access to the same full basement of the residence, which includes a bedroom area at the bottom of the stairs, and a combination work and living room area in the basement to the left of the stairs, all designed to be a living/sleeping area for a resident of the house.

NOW THEREFORE, IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI, I command that you search the person, place or thing above described within ten (10) days after filing the Application for Issuance of this Warrant, by day or night, as soon as practicable, and to take with you, if need be, the power of your county, and, if said above described property, or any part thereof, be found on said person, place or thing, that said property be seized or photographed, or copied and returned, or the photograph or copy, be brought to the Judge, who issued the Warrant to be dealt with according to law. That you make a complete and accurate inventory of the property so taken by you in the presence of the person from whose possession the same is taken, if that be possible, and to give to such person a Receipt for such property, together with a copy of the warrant, or, if no person be found in possession of said property, leaving said Receipt and copy of said warrant at the site of the search. After execution of the Search Warrant, the Warrant with a Return thereon, signed by the officer making the search, shall be delivered to the Judge who issued the Warrant, together with an itemized Receipt for said property taken.
